For this eNews I want to highlight some of the ministry events happening this week!

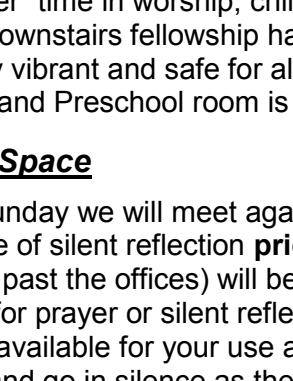
